Certificate in the Principles of Working with Individuals with Learning Disabilities

There are an estimated 1.4 million people living with a learning disability in the UK. The effects on individuals can vary widely, and people of every age and background are susceptible to developing such a disability.

This course will provide you with a comprehensive understanding of issues related to different types of learning disabilities and how these affect individuals in their daily lives. Those studying this course will consider a range of factors within this subject including safeguarding, positive risk-taking and awareness of the autism spectrum.

Course content:

The course is split into four manageable units.

Unit 2: Principles of safeguarding and protection in health and social care

Unit 3: Introduction to personalisation in social care

Unit 4: Principles of positive risk-taking for individuals with disabilities

Unit 5: Introductory awareness of autistic spectrum conditions

Unit 6: Principles of supporting individuals with a learning disability to access healthcare

Each unit contains activities and assessments designed to cover the specific learning outcomes.

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
